We present in this issue two works related to communication, but from different angles: Non-verbal communication in the initial formation of the Social Communicator, which theoretically analyzes the importance of skills in this area; The development of oral expression from the job training of students of the trade in hairdressing, offers a procedure that seeks to eradicate inadequacies that occur in the work performance of students of the aforementioned specialty.

Related to the technology we offer the works: Theoretical-methodological reflections for the teaching-learning process of the Engineering Career Programming and the Web as a tool for the orientation to university students in the use of educational technology, both aimed at the higher education.

The care and protection of the environment is a topic that is not exhausted, on the contrary, it is imminent to continue preparing new generations in this regard, and develop actions from educational centers to mitigate and prevent damage to this system: Sustainability environment. A way from the teaching of Botany, is an article that reveals the need to promote a change in the teaching conception of the program of this subject and helps to redirect its teaching so that students become multipliers of the information of the need of environmental sustainability; Learning and resilience in the local management of disaster risks, showed a program of actions that contributed to the increase of resilience to forest fires in three studied communities, and in a particular way, increased citizen participation in the socio-environmental transformations for the reduction of losses in the face of future events.
